

Additional Terms and Conditions Discovery Education Summer Institute 2018 (the “Competition”)

The following additional terms and conditions form part of the promotion information and rules for the above Competition, and should be read in conjunction with Discovery’s Competition General Terms and Conditions:

For the avoidance of doubt if there is any inconsistency between these additional terms and conditions and the General Competition Terms and Conditions, these additional terms and conditions shall prevail.

1. By entering this Competition, the entrant will be deemed to have read and understood these additional terms and conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.
2. The Competition is open to UK residents only, who are employed on a full-time basis as a Head Teacher, Deputy Head Teacher or Classroom Teacher, by a UK based school. Excluding employees of the Promoter and their families, the Promoter’s agents or anyone professionally associated with the competition. The school must be a subscriber to a Discovery Education Service.
3. Entrants who do not give correct details or those who make an entry on someone else’s behalf will be disqualified, at the Promoter’s discretion. No entrants from agents, third parties, organized groups or entries automatically generated by computer will be accepted. No bulk entries.
4. Entrants must be twenty-one (21) years old and above. Proof of identification may be required at the request of the Promoter. Entrants must meet the eligibility requirements as specified herein. Failure to meet the eligibility requirements may result in an entry being invalid and/or forfeiture of any prize.
5. Entrants expressly declare and represent that (i) they submit to English law and jurisdiction in participating in this Competition and (ii) they are individuals and not a company or any professional and/or commercial entity.
6. The promotion will open for entries from **15 February 2018** until **18 March 2018** (the “**Competition Period**”). The closing time for entries will be 23:45 on the closing date indicated above.
7. By entering, the winner agrees to participate in any publicity or promotional activities as may be reasonably required by the Promoter. Further the Promoter reserves the right to use the names of the winner in any publicity.

8. Method of Entry: The Competition can be entered through completing the online Competition entry form which can be found at <http://www.discoveryeducation.co.uk/summerinstitute>. As part of the application, entrants will be required to submit a two-minute video via YouTube outlining how they are transforming teaching and learning in their classroom including, details of themselves, a memorable teaching moment either experience or observed and something about themselves.

All entrants will be moderated to ensure they meet the set criteria, any entry not meeting the minimum criteria may be disqualified or amended at the Promoter's sole discretion. The Competition is limited to one entry per person.

9. Prize: Up to five (5) entrants will each win a trip to the Discovery Education Summer Institute professional development event taking place in North Carolina, USA from 15 July 2018 until 20 July 2018 (valued approximately £2,500 each). The prize will include:
- i. Return transfers to London Heathrow
 - ii. Overnight stay in a London Heathrow Airport on Hotel on Friday 13 July (if applicable)
 - iii. Return flights to Wilmington, NC (departing 14 July and returning 20 July 2018)
 - iv. Six nights full board accommodation (including breakfast, lunch and dinner each day) at the University of North Carolina, Wilmington Campus.
 - v. Return transfers from Wilmington airport to UNC Wilmington Campus
 - vi. USA ESTA fees
10. For all US trips, UK passport holders must hold a valid ESTA (electronic tourist visa) from the US embassy, which can be applied for a minimum of seventy-two (72) hours prior to travel. Anyone not holding an ESTA will be deported from the US upon arrival without exception. It is the winner's responsibility to comply with the ESTA visa requirements of the United States of America. Approval is at the discretion of the US embassy and the Promoter will not be held responsible for any delay or rejection.
11. The Prize Draw will take place before 23 March 2018. The winners will be contacted via email and must claim their prize by the 6 April 2018. If the prize is unclaimed after this time it will lapse and the Promoter reserves the right to offer the unclaimed prize to a substitute winner selected in accordance with these additional terms and condition.
12. The winners of the prize shall be selected by an independent judge from the Discovery Education Community team. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Promoter reserves the right to terminate or modify the Competition, modify these terms and conditions prior to the closing date, vary details of the prize, or substitute a prize of equivalent value should unforeseen circumstances require it.

14. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and non-refundable and there is no cash alternative in whole or in part. The prize is subject to availability. In the event of circumstances outside of its control the Promoter reserves the right to substitute a similar or alternative prize of equal or greater value. The prize must be taken by the winner unless agreed otherwise in writing by the Promoter.
15. Entries that are incomplete or late or those entries not in accordance with all the entry instructions are invalid. All submitted entries are the property of the Promoter and will not be returned.
