

Terms and conditions for the Active Kids Do Better/UK Athletics “Muller Anniversary Games 2018” free ticket prize-draw (the "Promotion")

By signing up to Active Kids Do Better on www.activekidsdobetter.co.uk and actively participating in the Promotion, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions (these "**Terms and Conditions**"). Promotional materials relating to the Promotion, including all information on how to enter the Promotion, also form part of these Terms and Conditions. In the event of any conflict between any terms referred to in such promotion materials and these Terms and Conditions, these Terms and Conditions take precedence.

1. The promoter of this Promotion is Discovery Education Europe Limited, Hythe House, 200 Shepherd's Bush Road, Hammersmith, London W6 7NL ("**Discovery Education**").
2. Participants must be a primary school teacher or teaching assistant age twenty-one (21) and above, and legally resident within the United Kingdom (including Northern Ireland). Employees and agents of Discovery Education or any of its subsidiary or affiliated companies and their immediate families and members of their households, and anyone otherwise connected with operation or fulfilment of the Promotion are not eligible to take part. Discovery Education reserves the right to require participants to prove that they are eligible to enter the Promotion. If the winner is found to be ineligible, Discovery Education reserves the right to award the tickets to another participant and to require the return of any tickets already awarded.
3. The Promotion commences at 09:00 GMT on the 25th June 2018 and all prize-draw entries must be received by 17:00 GMT on the closing date of the 6th July 2018.
4. Entry to the prize-draw is free; no purchase is necessary. Participants who email must include full name, job title, school email address, school name, school postcode and local authority. Entries submitted by any other means will not be accepted: only those submitted via the official method of entry.
5. The prize-draw will be promoted on www.activekidsdobetter.co.uk (the "**Website**") and Discovery Education's Facebook, Twitter and Instagram accounts. Use of script, macro or any automated system to enter the prize-draw is prohibited and entries made (or which appear to have been made) using any such system may be treated as void. Any illegible, incomplete or fraudulent entries will be rejected. Participants may make a maximum of one entry to the Promotion but multiple participants from the same school may enter the Promotion, any additional entries in addition to this may be disqualified. Twenty (20) schools will be awarded the complimentary tickets,. Only the tickets will be provided, Discovery Education will not be responsible for travel costs to and from the venue or for any incidental costs incurred during the event. Schools/ individuals attending the event are responsible for paying all personal or incidental expenses and any VAT, national and/or local tax liabilities incurred in claiming or using the Gift. The prize-draw will be performed by a random computer process and will take place on **9th July 2018**.
9. Successful participants will be notified by **12:00 GMT on 10th July 2018** by email from ActiveKidsDoBetter@Discovery.com that they qualify for 100 complimentary tickets for their class/school. Participants will be required to submit valid identification before receiving their complimentary tickets (the Gift) and school address details for delivery of the Gift. Successful participants must claim their prize via email to ActiveKidsDoBetter@Discovery.com no later than **17:00 GMT on 13th July 2018**. If the Gift is unclaimed after this time, it will lapse, and Discovery Education reserves the right to offer the unclaimed Gift to a substitute participant selected in accordance with these terms and conditions.
10. Complimentary tickets (the Gift) will be sent to eligible participants by **15th July 2018** by registered post to a postal address within the UK notified by participants in advance. Discovery Education will not seek to deliver the complimentary tickets by any other means. Successful participants will be solely responsible for subsequently distributing the 100 complimentary tickets within their school to their pupils' families/carers. Children aged two (2) years and above and all other ticket holders will require an individual ticket per person in order to gain access to the venue.

In the event that, for reasons beyond Discovery Education's reasonable control and not related to the operation of the Promotion, Discovery Education is unable to award the complimentary tickets as described in these Terms and Conditions, Discovery Education reserves the right to award a promotional item of a similar nature and an equivalent value.

Although the Promotion may be featured on Facebook and/or Twitter and/or Instagram it is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook and/or Twitter and/or Instagram and you agree that Facebook and/or Twitter and/or Instagram are not liable in any way. You are providing information to Discovery Education and not to Facebook and/or Twitter. The information you provide will only be used for the purposes referred to in clause 14 below.
13. By entering the Promotion, participants agree to have their name and photograph featured in publicity materials relating to the Promotion without further reference, payment or other compensation. 14. Discovery Education will collect and process participants' personal information in order to conduct the Promotion including to allow the complimentary tickets to be delivered. If participants do not provide any of the mandatory information requested when entering or taking part in the Promotion, they shall not be eligible to receive complimentary tickets. Discovery Education reserves the right to modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Promotion in whole or in part, at its sole discretion, if it believes the Promotion is not capable of being conducted as specified within these Terms and Conditions or in the event of a virus, a computer bug or unauthorized human intervention or any other cause that is beyond the reasonable control of Discovery Education that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality or normal course of the Promotion. Neither Discovery Education nor any of its subsidiary or affiliated companies are responsible for any condition, circumstances, losses, failures or delays

caused by events beyond its or their control such as (but not limited to) the acts or defaults of any supplier selected by Discovery Education to provide the Gift or otherwise that may cause the Promotion to be disrupted or corrupted, or that may lead to loss or damage of the Gifts in transit to participants.

19. These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law. The courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to hear any dispute or claim arising in association with the Promotion or these Terms and Conditions.
