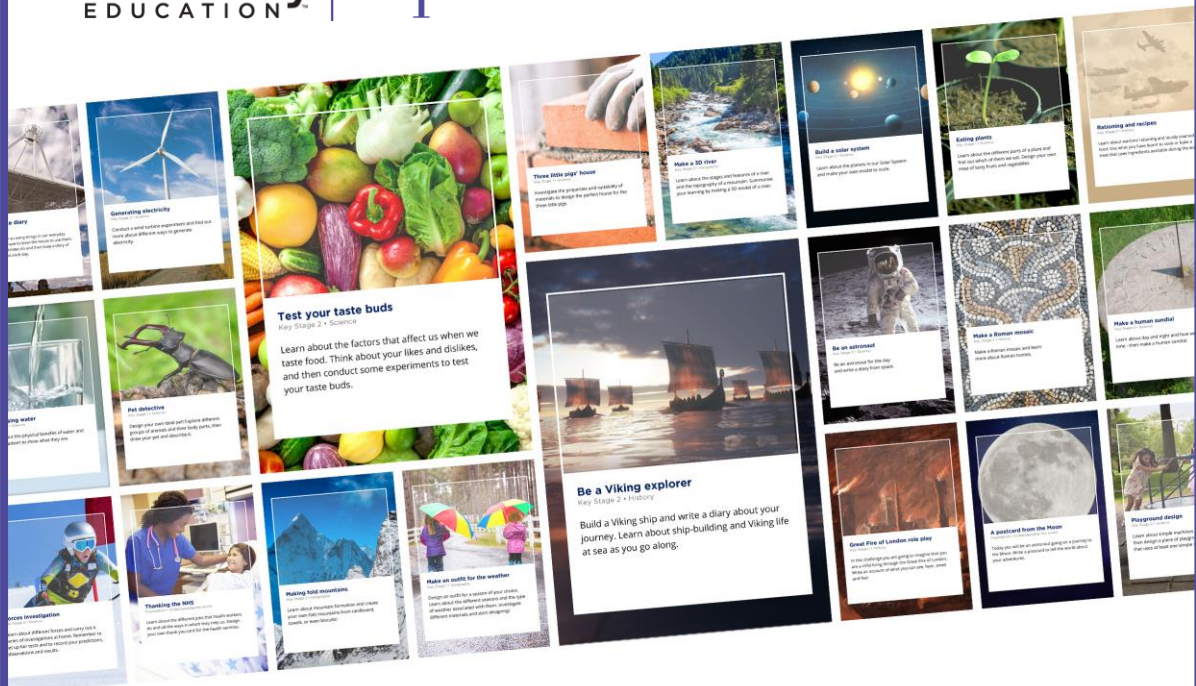

Preview of pupil steps:

1. You're going to design the perfect outfit for one of the four seasons. First, lets investigate what the weather is usually like. This will help you work out what the outfit should be like.
2. Watch this video about the seasons. What clothes might you need in Winter? It's dark as well as cold, is there something that you could wear that would help? What would you take with you if it was hot outside? What if it was raining?
3. Think about different materials you know. Which ones would be best for these jobs? What properties should they have? How could you test these? Choose one of these.
4. Which item are you going to investigate from step 3?
How will you test which materials would be best for this?
5. Record your results below. Is this what you expected to find?
Which would be the best material to use?
6. It's time to design your outfit! Using what you've found out about different seasons and different materials, draw and label the perfect outfit for your chosen season.
