In this challenge you are going to imagine that you are a child living through the Great Fire of London. Write an account of what you can see, hear, smell and feel.

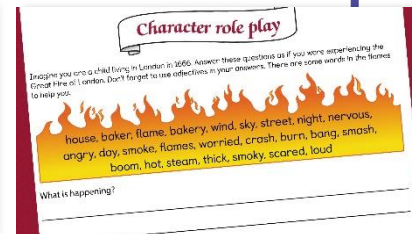
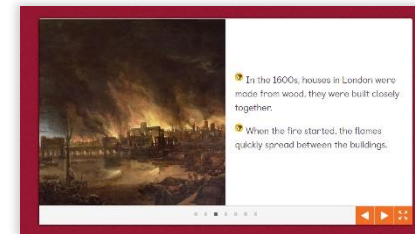

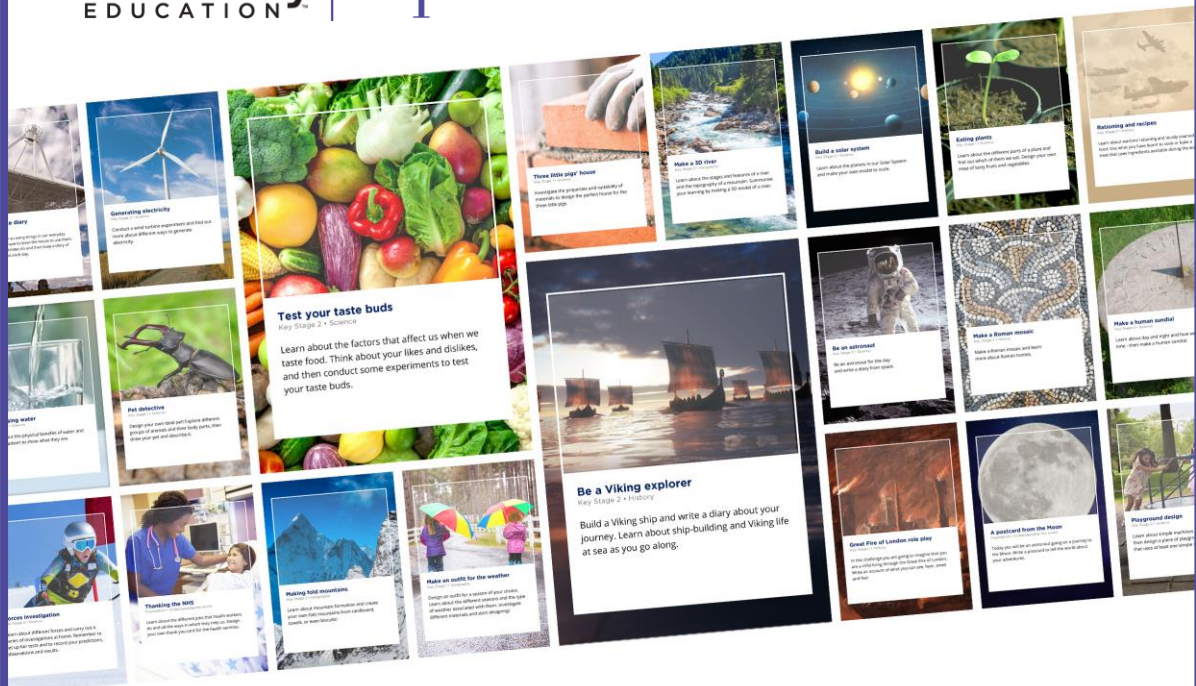


### Preview of pupil steps:

3. Read or listen to this book to see what happened. How do we know this information? What evidence might have been left behind?
4. Watch this video to help you imagine what you might have been able to see or hear during the Great Fire.
5. Time to get into character! Imagine you're a child during the Great Fire. How would you answer these questions? Can you draw and label what you would have seen?
