

# Reporting from the war

## Research



Show children newspaper reports about WWI. Ask them to think about research journalists who reported during the war. Consider the following:

- Where the journalists might have been when they wrote these news stories.
- How they got around.
- How they found accurate information and sources.
- How they would have shared their news stories with other people.
- What impact technology has had on the field of journalism.

## Write

As a contrast, children could prepare a news report about the way their school or local community commemorates Remembrance Day.
