

Additional Terms and Conditions

Discovery Education Summer Institute Competition – 15/03/2016 – 03/05/2016

The following additional terms and conditions form part of the promotion information and rules for the above Competition, and should be read in conjunction with Discovery's Competition General Terms and Conditions:

For the avoidance of doubt if there is any inconsistency between these additional terms and conditions and the General Competition Terms and Conditions, these additional terms and conditions shall prevail.

1. By entering this Competition, the entrant will be deemed to have read and understood these additional terms and conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.
2. The Competition is open to UK based teachers working at a school that subscribes to a Discovery Education service only.
3. Entrants who do not give correct details or those who make an entry on someone else's behalf will be disqualified, at the Promoter's discretion. No entries from agents, third parties, organized group or entries automatically generated by computer will be accepted. No bulk entries.
4. Entrants must be twenty one (21) years old and above. Proof of identification may be required at the request of the Promoter. Entrants must meet the eligibility requirements as specified herein. Failure to meet the eligibility requirements may result in an entry being invalid and/or forfeiture of any prize.
5. Entrants expressly declare and represent that (i) they submit to English law and jurisdiction in participating in this Competition and (ii) they are individuals and not a company or any professional and/or commercial entity.
6. This promotion will open for entries from **15 March 2016** until **3 May 2016** (the "**Competition Period**"). The closing time for entries will be 17:00 on the closing date indicated above.
7. By entering, the winner agrees to participate in any publicity or promotional activities as may be reasonably required by the Promoter. Further the Promoter reserves the right to use the names of the winner in any publicity.
8. Method of Entry: The Competition can be entered by completing the online Competition entry form which can be found at <https://lrougeux.wufoo.com/forms/den-summer-institute-2016-application/>. As part of the application, entrants will be required to submit a two minute video via YouTube outlining how they are transforming teaching and learning in their classroom, including details of themselves, a memorable teaching moment either experienced or observed and something about themselves or their life outside of teaching. All entries will be moderated to ensure they meet the set criteria. Any entry not meeting the minimum criteria may be disqualified or amended in Promoter's sole discretion. The Competition is limited to one entry per person.

9. Prize: Eight (8) entrants will each win a trip to the Professional Development Summer Institute Programme taking place in Chicago, United States from 16 July 2016 until 22 July 2016 (valued at approximately £2,500 each). The prize will include the following:
 - (i) Return transfers to London Heathrow Airport;
 - (ii) Overnight stay in a London Heathrow Airport Hotel on Friday 15 July (if required);
 - (iii) Return flights to Chicago (departing 16 July 2016 and returning 22 July 2016);
 - (iv) Six (6) nights' full board accommodation (including breakfast, lunch and dinner each day) at Loyola University Campus;
 - (v) Return transfers from Chicago airport to Loyola University Campus;
 - (vi) USA ESTA visa fees for one (1) person.
10. For all US trips, UK passport holders must hold a valid ESTA (electronic tourist visa) from the US embassy, which can be applied for a minimum seventy two (72) hours prior to travel. Anyone not holding an ESTA will be deported from the US upon arrival without exception. It is the winner's responsibility to comply with the ESTA visa requirements of the United States of America. Approval is at the discretion of the US embassy and the Promoter will not be held responsible for any delay or rejection.
11. The Prize Draw will take place on 9 May 2016. The winners will be contacted via email and must claim their prize within six (6) days of the notification. If the prize is unclaimed after this time, it will lapse and the Promoter reserves the right to offer the unclaimed prize to a substitute winner selected in accordance with these additional terms and conditions.
12. The winners of the prize shall be selected by an independent judge from the Community Leadership Council. The decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Promoter reserves the right to terminate or modify the Competition, modify these terms and conditions prior to the closing date, vary details of the prize, or substitute a prize of equivalent value should unforeseen circumstances require it.
14. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and non-refundable and there is no cash alternative in whole or in part. The prize is subject to availability. In the event of circumstances outside of its control the Promoter reserves the right to substitute a similar or alternative prize of equal or greater value. The prize must be taken by the winner unless agreed otherwise in writing by the Promoter.
15. Entries that are incomplete or late or those entries not in accordance with all the entry instructions are invalid. All submitted entries are the property of the Promoter and will not be returned.
