

## **Additional Terms and Conditions**

### **Make Your World Bigger Competition Foundation Stage – Year 5 - 15/08/2016 – 16/09/2016 (the “Competition”)**

For the avoidance of doubt if there is any inconsistency between these additional terms and conditions and the General Competition Terms and Conditions, these additional terms and conditions shall prevail.

1. By entering this Competition, the Entrant (as defined at Clause 4) will be deemed to have read and understood these additional terms and conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.
2. The Competition is open to UK primary school pupils in Foundation Stage or Years one (1) to five (5) only and aged four (4) to ten (10) years old, excluding employees of Promoter (details of which are set out in paragraph 18) and their families, the Promoter's agents or anyone professionally associated with the promotion (the “**Participant**” or “**Winner**” as applicable).
3. Entrants (as defined at Clause 4) who do not give correct details or those who make an entry on someone else’s behalf other than the Participant will be disqualified, at the Promoter’s discretion. No entries from agents, third parties, organized group or entries automatically generated by computer will be accepted. No bulk entries.
4. The Competition must be entered by a parent, guardian or teacher on behalf of the Participant (the “**Entrant**”). Proof of identification may be required at the request of the Promoter. Entrants and Participants must meet the eligibility requirements as specified herein. Failure to meet the eligibility requirements may result in an entry being invalid and/or forfeiture of any prize.
5. Entrants expressly declare and represent that (i) they submit to English law and jurisdiction in participating in this Competition and (ii) they are individuals and not a company or any professional and/or commercial entity.
6. This promotion will open for entries from 12:00 on **Monday 15 August** until **Friday 16 September 2016** (the “**Competition Period**”). The closing time for entries will be 17:00 on the closing date indicated above.
7. By entering, the Entrant agrees that the Winner will participate in any publicity or promotional activities as may be reasonably required by the Promoter. Further the Promoter reserves the right to use the name of the Winner in any publicity.
